

## What Your Pledge to United Way of Southeast Mississippi Can Do

### A Pledge of:

#### \$4-\$8 a month (\$48-\$96 total gift)

- Supports one Scoutreach youth for one year of character building, citizenship training and physical fitness based activities. (Boy Scouts)
- Purchases much-needed school supplies for five children at Aldersgate Mission.
- Purchases journals for children to express their feelings. (South Miss. Children's Center.)
- Allows 8 girls to learn strong values, conviction and self-worth. (Girl Scouts)
- Provides a meal for 12 developmentally challenged children during a respite. (ARC)
- Will shelter a homeless person one night and give them two meals in a safe, comfortable, clean environment with laundry facilities and access to social service assistance. (The Salvation Army)

#### \$12-\$23 a month (\$144-\$276 total gift)

- Enables a victim advocate to spend two days in court supporting a sexual assault victim. (Shafer Center for Crisis Intervention)
- Provides 18 hours of mentoring services to an at-risk youth. (Big Brothers Big Sisters)
- Provides emergency communications for military families each month. (American Red Cross)
- Purchases a quality front door, a kitchen sink and four smoke detectors for a Habitat for Humanity home.

#### \$24-\$40 a month (\$288-\$480 total gift)

- Purchases books for 25 students in DREAM's after-school tutoring program.
- Sponsors and financially supports two school-based mentoring matches or one community-based match of children in need of a caring adult. (Big Brothers Big Sisters)
- Provides specialized seating for developmentally delayed children who have physical disabilities. (Children's Center for Communication and Development)
- Provides 20 to 25 comfort kits (toiletries, etc.) for members of families whose homes have been destroyed by disaster. (American Red Cross)
- Provides counseling to a victim of abuse and houses her family in a shelter for one week. (Domestic Abuse Family Shelter)
- Provides an hour-long Parent Aide visit per week for an expectant or new mother. (Center for the Prevention of Child Abuse)
- Purchases one 40-gallon water heater to allow a child to have a warm bath. (Habitat for Humanity)

#### \$44-\$80 a month (\$528-\$960 total gift)

- Allows a child to participate in the after-school and summer programming in the safe and character-building environment of the Salvation Army Boys and Girls Club for an entire year.
- Provides summer programming and alternative activities for 15 students at the DREAM Center.
- Provides one full weekend of respite for 12 children at the ARC home.
- Provides 12 parenting/counseling sessions for families coping with a child with a significant communication disability. (DuBard School for Language Disorders)
- Provides clothing for 12 victims (one per month) of a single-family fire. (American Red Cross)
- Purchases or repairs medical equipment that is essential for an individual with a disability to maintain his or her independence (LIFE of Mississippi)
- Provides 3 meals for 50 to 100 people in a disaster evacuation shelter. (American Red Cross/The Salvation Army)
- Allows R<sup>3</sup>SM to purchase building materials to repair an elderly client's roof
- Provides clothing for a child who comes with nothing to South Mississippi Children's Center
- Provides one hour of in-home therapy per month for medically fragile infants and toddlers (Children's Center for Communication and Development)
